Through the programme, whole communities are working together to save the world's most degraded lands. The many benefits these fast-growing trees bring allow families to save their homes and way of life.


The Natural Fertility Clinic helps couples to conceive the natural way, through a variety of natural therapies such as reflexology, acupuncture and medical herbalism.
